As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above the Director of State Lotteries is empowered to make changes in the prize structure and terms and conditions of various schemes conducted by the Kerala State Lotteries Department.

In the light of the above, para 12,13 and 14 of the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the Annexure I (b) of the prize structure of the Kairali Weekly Lottery read as 2nd above shall be amended as follows:-

Para 12

- (i) “Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase for the draw irrespective of the district of purchase”.
- (a) Upto 5,00,000 tickets – 78.5% of the maximum retail price.
(b) 5,00,001 and above - 78.25% of the maximum retail price.
- (ii) In addition to the above discount the agents will be allowed a special discount @ 10% by converting the agents prize on 8th prize. Hence the agents shall not be eligible for agents prize on 8th prize separately.
- (iii) The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency was registered.

Para 13

“Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase the maximum number of tickets for each draw”.

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of the next lower purchaser.

Para 14

Common incentive of Rs.1,000/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1,500 tickets. If two or more agents in any of the district, purchases equal number of tickets and become eligible for common incentive, the amount will be divided among them equally.

This amendment shall take effect from Kairaly 1376th draw onwards.
