TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Tickets will be printed in five series.
- 2 The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only.
One book of tickets will contain **10** tickets.
- 3 The first prize will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
- 4 The second prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits once and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 5 The third to sixth prizes will be determined by drawing the last three digits once and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 6 The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits twice and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 7 The eighth prize will be determined by drawing three digits ten times and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 8 If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
- 9 An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1st and 2nd prizes and will be given to the agents concerned as agents prize. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money on third and fourth prizes and Rs.30/- on fifth, Rs.20/- on sixth and Rs. 10/-each on seventh and eighth prizes will be given as agents prize from Government Fund.
- 10 Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates for the entire purchase for the draw irrespective of the District of registration.

(a) Upto 5000 tickets	- 88% of the maximum retail price
(b) Between 5,001 and 25,000 tickets	- 87.5% of the maximum retail price
(c) Between 25,001 and 1,50,000 tickets	- 87% of the maximum retail price
(d) Between 1,50,001 and 3,50,000 tickets	- 86.5% of the maximum retail price
(e) Between 3,50,001 and 5,50,000 tickets	- 86% of the maximum retail price
(f) Above 5,50,000 tickets	- 85.5% of the maximum retail price

The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an Agency. The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the Office of registration.

11. Common incentive price of Rs.500/- will be awarded to the agents registered in each District who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 5000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets in a District the amount will be divided among them.

12. The prize -winning tickets should be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The 1st prize winning ticket should be surrendered in the Directorate of State Lotteries in person or by insured registered post or through Nationalised/Scheduled banks or State/District co-operative banks supported by necessary documents.
13. The prizes of Rs.10,000/- and below may be claimed from the District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state, prize winning tickets should be surrendered in the Directorate. The prize -winners should record their name, address and signature on the reverse of the tickets specified for the purpose. But the same is not obligatory for claiming the sixth to eighth prizes. Payment on first to fifth prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the counterfoils concerned or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.
14. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets oworth prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below and pay the the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on the be half of the prize winner by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prize tickets are collected and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them while presenting the same for payment.
15. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright.
16. One ticket can win only one prize i.e, the highest prize offered.
17. Income Tax and Surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act (Central).
18. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
