**CHAITHANYA NEW WEEKLY LOTTERY  
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only.
3. The first and second prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes against the number of tickets printed. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The third prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits from 1,000<sup>th</sup> to unit place once and will be extended all sold tickets in all series.
5. The fourth and fifth prizes will be determined by drawing the last three digits from 100<sup>th</sup> place to unit place, once and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits from 100<sup>th</sup> place to unit place twice and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits from 100<sup>th</sup> place to unit place three times and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The eighth prize will be determined by drawing two digits from 10<sup>th</sup> and unit place twice and add/subtract 20 to the drawn number so as to get 8 more numbers and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
9. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redraw.
10. Consolation prize of Rs.1000/- each will be awarded to four tickets in other four series of the 1<sup>st</sup> prize winning number.
11. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prizes and will be given to the concerned agents. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money on third and fifth prizes and consolation prizes will be given to the concerned agents from Government fund. An amount of Rs.20 will be given as agents prize on sixth prize from Government Fund. Rs.10 will also be given as agents prize on seventh prize and eighth prize from Government Fund.
12. Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.

(a) up to 5000 tickets	-	80% of the maximum retail price
(b) Up to 25,000 tickets	-	79% of the maximum retail price
(c) Above 25000 tickets	-	78.5% of the maximum retail price
(d) 4 Lakhs and above	-	78% of the maximum retail price

The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency was registered.

13. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase the maximum number of tickets in India as follows:-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of the next lower purchaser.

14. Common incentive of Rs.500/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1000 tickets. If two or more agents in any of the district or other state section, purchases equal number of tickets and become eligible of common incentive, the amount will be divided among them equally.

15. The prize-winning tickets must be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The first prize tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person, by insured registered post or through Nationalized/Scheduled banks supported by necessary documents.

16. The prizes of Rs.50,000/- and below may be claimed through the concerned District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries in the case of claimants from outside the state. The prizewinners should record their name, address and signature on the reverse of the tickets specified for the purpose. But it is not obligatory for claiming the seventh, eighth prizes. Payment on first to fifth prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils of the prize-winning ticket.

17. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright.

18. One ticket can win only one prize ie., the highest prize offered.

19. Income Tax and surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act.

20. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
