ANNEXURE – III

KANAKADHARA MONTHLY LOTTERY

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Tickets will be printed in five series.
- 2 The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.50/- only. One book of tickets will contain **20** tickets.
- 3 All the prizes will be in Gold Coins only, having **999.9** purity.
- 4 The first, second and third prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
- 5 The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits four times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 6 The fifth prize will be determined by drawing the last three digits once and add /subtract 200 so as to get another four numbers.
- 7 If any prize number in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
- 8 An amount of Rs.1,50,000, Rs.10,000, Rs.5,000, Rs.2,000 and Rs.750 each will be given as agents' commission on prize for first to fifth prizes respectively from Government fund.
- 9 (i) Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates.

(a) Up to 1,000 tickets	-	79 % of the maximum retail price
(b) Up to 4,00,000 tickets	-	78 % of the maximum retail price
(c) 4,00,001 and above	-	77.5 % of the maximum retail price

(ii) The highest eligible rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency is registered.
10. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows:-

(1) For the highest purchaser	-	Rs.10,000/-
(2) For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.8,000/-
(3) For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.6,000/-
(4) For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.4,000/-
(5) For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.2000/-

If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the special incentive will be divided among them equally subject to the minimum amount of the next lowest purchaser.

- 11 Common incentive prizes I and II will be given to the agents for the highest purchase of tickets in each district of and above 1000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the amount will be divided among them equally.

Common incentive Prize I	Rs.1000/-
Common incentive Prize II	Rs.750/-

- 12 The prize-winning tickets should be surrendered within **30** days from the date of draw. The prize winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse of the tickets. The first, second and third prize winning tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by Insured Registered post or through any branch of the State Bank of India in Kerala supported with necessary documents. All other prizes can be claimed through the District offices of the State Lotteries department or through any branch of the **State Bank of India in Kerala**. The disbursement of all the prizes will be done only through the designated branches of State Bank of India in Kerala.
- 13 In the case of claimants from outside the state the claims should be submitted in the Directorate. Payment of prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.
- 14 The prizewinners should collect the prizes within **21** days from the date of intimation from the Lotteries Department from the designated branch of the State Bank of India in any of the districts in Kerala chosen by the prizewinner.
- 15 VAT, Income Tax , Cess and any other Tax or Surcharge applicable will be paid from Government Fund and there for the Income Tax, Cess etc to be paid by the prizewinner will be treated as part of the prize.
- 16 Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only one prize i.e., the highest prize offered. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
