**PERIYAR WEEKLY LOTTERY**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**  
**(VIDE ORDER NO. S1/4867/2004/DSL DATED 23/03/2004)**

1. Tickets will be printed in three series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only.
3. The first second and third prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes against the number of tickets printed. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The consolation prizes of Rs 5,000/- each will be given to the tickets in other two series having the same number
5. The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits four times and will be extended all sold tickets in all series.
6. The fifth prizes will be determined by drawing the last five digits ten times and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last 4 digits three times and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The seventh prize will be awarded to all sold tickets in all series ending with the last three digits of the first prize-winning number.
9. The eighth prize will be awarded to all sold tickets in all series ending with the last three digits of the second prize-winning number.
10. The ninth prize will be determined by drawing last two digits from 10th to unit place ten times and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series
11. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
12. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes and will be given to the concerned agents. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money on fourth to sixth and consolation prizes will be given to the concerned agents from Government fund. An amount of Rs.20 /- will be given as agents prize on seventh prize and Rs.10 /- each will be given as agents prize on eighth and ninth prizes also from Government Fund.
13. Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, as per the existing govt orders
  - (a) up to 100 tickets - 75% of the maximum retail price
  - (b) 101 to 50,000 tickets - 72.5% of the maximum retail price
  - (c) 50,001 to 7,00,000 tickets - 72% of the maximum retail price
  - (d) 7,00,001 and above tickets - 71.5% of the maximum retail price

14. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase the maximum number of tickets in India as follows:-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of the next lower purchaser.

15. Common incentive of Rs.500/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1000 tickets. If two or more agents in any of the district or other state section, purchases equal number of tickets and become eligible of common incentive, the amount will be divided among them equally.

16. The prize-winning tickets must be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person, by insured registered post or through Nationalised/Scheduled banks supported by necessary documents.

17. The prizes of Rs.50,000/- and below may be claimed through the concerned District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries in the case of claimants from outside the state. The prize winners should record their name, address and signature on the reverse of the tickets specified for the purpose. But it is not obligatory for claiming the eighth and ninth prizes. Payment on first to seventh prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils of the prize winning ticket.

18. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright.

19. One ticket can win only one prize ie., the highest prize offered.

20. Income Tax and surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act.

21. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
