TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Tickets will be printed in five series.
- 2 The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.20/- only. One book of tickets will contain **20** tickets.
- 3 Prizes in gold coins will be in 999.9 purity.
- 4) The first, second and third prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
- 5) The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits 1 time and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 6) The fifth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits 1 time and extended to all sold tickets in all series
- 7) The Sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last two digits 10 times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 8) If any prize numbers in any category is repeated ,the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
- 9) An amount of Rs.5,00,000, Rs.20,000, Rs.10,000, Rs.2,000, Rs.1,000 each will be given as agents' commission on prize for first to fifth prizes respectively from Government fund.
- 10) (i) Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates.

(a) Up to 1000 tickets	-	79 % of the maximum retail price
(b) 1001 to 10000 tickets	-	78.5 % of the maximum retail price
(c) 10001 to 2,00,000 tickets	-	78 % of the maximum retail price
(d) 2,00,001 to 4,00,000 tickets	-	77.5% of the maximum retail price
(e) Above 4 Lakh tickets	-	77% of the maximum retail price

(ii) In addition to the above discount the agents will be allowed a special discount of 10% by converting the Agents Commission @ 100% on VI prize. Hence the Agents will not be eligible for Agents Commission on VI th Prize separately

(iii) The highest eligible rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency is registered.

- 11 Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows:-

- If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the special incentive will be divided among them equally subject to the minimum amount of the next lowest purchaser.
- 12 Common incentive prize I and II will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the amount will be divided among them equally subject to the minimum of common incentive prize II

13. The prize winning tickets should be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The prize winners should record their **name, address and signature** in the space provided on the reverse of the tickets. The **first and second** prize winning tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by Insured Registered post or through any branch of the **State Bank of India** in Kerala supported with necessary documents. 3rd, 4th and 5th prizes can be claimed through the District offices of the State Lotteries department or through any branch of the **State Bank of India** in Kerala. **The VI prizes can be claimed from District Lottery Offices. Disbursement of Gold Coins will be done only through the designated branches of State Bank of India in Kerala.**
14. Payment of prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.
- 15 The prize winners of Gold should collect the prizes within 21 days from the date of receipt of intimation from the Lotteries Department from the designated branch of the State Bank of India in Kerala chosen by the prize winner.**
- 16 Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets of the VIth prize and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prized tickets are collected, and the prize money already paid to the prize winners by them while presenting the same for payment.
- 17 Sales Tax, Income Tax and any other Tax or Surcharge if any applicable on Gold Prizes will be treated as part of the prize and will be paid from Government Fund.
- 18 Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only one prize i.e., the highest prize offered. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
