TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only. One book of tickets will contain 25 tickets.
3. The first and second prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes against the number of tickets printed. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The third prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits 5 times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
5. The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The fifth ,sixth and seventh prizes will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The eighth prize will be determined by drawing the last 2 digits 10 times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
9. Consolation prize of Rs.5000/- each will be awarded to four tickets in other four series of the 1st prize winning number.
10. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1st and 2nd prizes and will be given to the agents concerned as commission on prize. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money on third to fifth and consolation prizes, 20 % on 6th and 40% on 7th prizes will be given to the agents concerned as commission on prize from Government fund.
11. (i) Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.

(a)	Up to 1000 tickets	-	79% of the maximum retail price
(c)	Above 1000 tickets	-	78.5% of the maximum retail price
(d)	5 Lakhs and above	-	78.25% of the maximum retail price
- (ii) In addition to the above discount, the agents will be allowed a special discount @ 10% by converting the agents commission on VIII prize. Hence agents shall not be eligible for agents commission on VIII prize separately.
- (iii) The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency was registered.
12. When the total sales exceeds 12,00,000 tickets in a draw, agents who purchase 5,00,000 or more will be awarded a sales incentive @ 0.75%of the maximum retail price of the tickets purchased. The amount will be given after the draw.

13. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase the maximum number of tickets in India as follows:-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of the next lower purchaser.

14 Common incentive prize of Rs.1000/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases equal number of tickets the amount will be divided among them equally.

15 The prize winning tickets should be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The first prize winning ticket should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person, insured registered post or through Nationalised /Scheduled banks /State or District Co-operative Banks supported with necessary documents. The prize winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse of the tickets. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time except in the case of VI to VIII prizes.

16 The prizes of Rs.100000/- and below may be claimed through the concerned District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state, the claims should be submitted in the Directorate.

17 Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prized tickets are collected, and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them, while presenting the same for payment.

18 Claims on torn, mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only one prize ie. the highest prize offered. Income Tax and surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act (Central).

19 Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

- 1 Tickets will be printed in five series.
- 2 The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only. One book of tickets will contain 25 tickets.
- 3 The first and second prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes against the number of tickets printed. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
- 4 The third prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits 5 times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 5 The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 6 The fifth and sixth prizes will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 7 The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last 3 digits thrice and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
- 8 The eighth prize will be determined by drawing the last 2 digits ten times and extended to all sold tickets in all series
- 9 If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
- 10 Consolation prize of Rs.5000/- each will be awarded to four tickets in other four series of the 1st prize winning number.
- 11 An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1st and 2nd prizes and will be given to the agents concerned as commission on prize. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money on third to fifth and consolation prizes, 20 % on 6th and 50% on 7th prizes will be given to the agents concerned as commission on prize from Government fund.
- 12 (i) Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.
 - (a) Up to 5,00,000 tickets -78.5% of the maximum retail price
 - (b) 5,00,001 and above -78.25% of the maximum retail price
- (ii) In addition to the above discount, the agents will be allowed a special discount @ 10% by converting the agents commission on VIII prize. Hence agents shall not be eligible for agents commission on VIII prize separately.

(iii) The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office where the agency was registered.

.13. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase the maximum number of tickets in India as follows:-

(1)	For the highest purchaser	-	Rs.5,000/-
(2)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.3,000/-
(3)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.2,000/-
(4)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.1,500/-
(5)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.1,250/-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of the next lower purchaser.

14 Common incentive prize of Rs.1000/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1500 tickets. If more than one agent purchases equal number of tickets the amount will be divided among them equally.

15. The prize winning tickets should be surrendered within 30 days from the date of draw. The first prize winning ticket should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person, insured registered post or through Nationalised /Scheduled banks /State or District Coperative Banks supported with necessary documents. The prize winners should record their name , address and signature in the space provided on the reverse of the tickets. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time except in the case of VI to VIII prizes.

16. The prizes of Rs.100000/- and below may be claimed through the concerned District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state, the claims should be submitted in the Directorate.
