TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.50/- only.
3. One book of tickets will contain **10** tickets
4. The first prize will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes against the number of tickets sold. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
5. The second prize will be determined by drawing the last **5** digits once, and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The third prize will be determined by drawing the last **3** digits twice, and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The fourth and fifth prizes will be determined by drawing the last **3** digits once, and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last **3** digits twice, and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
9. The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last **3** digits ten times, and will be extended to all sold tickets in all series.
10. If any prize number in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
11. Consolation prize of Rs.25, 000/- each will be awarded to four tickets in other four series of the 1st prize winning number.
12. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1st, 2nd and consolation prizes, and will be given as agents prize to the agents concerned. An amount equal to 20% of the prize money on 3rd to 5th prizes and 25% on 6th prize and 50% on 7th prize will be given to the agents concerned as agents prize from Government fund.
13. Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of registration.

(a) Upto 1000 tickets	-80% of the maximum retail price
(b) Between 1,001 and 5,000 tickets	-79.5% of the maximum retail price
(c) Between 5,001 and 25,000 tickets	- 79% of the maximum retail price
(d) Between 25,001 and 1,50,000 tickets	-78.5 % of the maximum retail price
(e) Between 1,50,001 and 3,50,000 tickets	-78% of the maximum retail price
(f) Between 3,50,001 and 5,50,000 tickets	-77.5 % of the maximum retail price
(g) Above 5,50,000 tickets	- 77% of the maximum retail price

The highest eligible rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency . The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any, will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery, as the case may be, from the office of registration.

14. Common incentive prize of Rs.2000/- will be awarded to the agents registered in each district who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 5000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases equal number of tickets in a district, the amount will be divided among them.
15. The prize winning tickets should be surrendered within **30** days from the date of draw. The 1st prize winning ticket should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or through insured registered post or through Nationalized/Scheduled Banks or State/District Co-operative Banks supported by necessary documents.
16. The prizes of Rs.50,000/- and below may be claimed through the District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state the prize winners should surrender the tickets in the Directorate. The prize winners should record their name, address and signature on the reverse of the tickets specified for the purpose. But the same is not obligatory for claiming the seventh prize. Payment on first to sixth prizes will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the counterfoils concerned.
17. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below, pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prize tickets are collected, and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them while presenting the same for payment.
17. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright.
One ticket can win only one prize ie., the highest prize offered.
Income Tax and Surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act (Central).
18. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
