ANNEXURE – III

SUN-FUN WEEKLY LOTTERY

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.10/- only. One book of tickets will contain **25** tickets.
3. The first and second prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under the variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The third prize will be determined by drawing the last five digits five times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
5. The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The fifth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits five times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last three digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last three digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
9. The eighth prize will be determined by drawing the last two digits ten times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
10. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
11. Consolation prize of Rs.5000/- each will be given to the tickets in other four series of the 1st prize winning number.
12. An amount equivalent to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from the 1st and 2nd prizes and given to the agents concerned as agents' commission on prize. An amount equivalent to 10% of the prize money on third to fifth and consolation prizes, and 20% on 6th and 7th prizes will be given to the agents concerned as agents' commission on prize from Government fund.
13. (i) Registered agents can purchase tickets at the following discounted rates.

| (c) Up to 400000 tickets | - | 78% of the maximum retail price |
| (d) Above 4 Lakhs tickets | - | 77.5% of the maximum retail price |

(ii) In addition to the above discount the agents will be allowed a special discount @ 10% by converting the agents commission @ 100% on VIII prize. Hence the agents will not be eligible for agents' commission on VIII prize separately.

(iii) The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected if any will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery as the case may be from the office of registration.

14. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows: -

(1)	For the highest purchaser	-	Rs.5,000/-
(2)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.3,000/-
(3)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.2,000/-
(4)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.1,000/-
(5)	For the next highest purchaser	-	Rs.750/-

If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the special incentive will be divided among them equally subject to the minimum amount of the next lowest purchaser.

15. Common incentive prize of Rs.500/- each will be given to the agents in each district, who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 1000 tickets. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets the amount will be divided among them equally.

16. The prize-winning ticket should be surrendered within **30** days from the date of draw. The first prize winning ticket should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by insured registered post or through Nationalised/Scheduled banks /State or District Co-Operative banks supported with necessary documents.

17. The prizes of Rs.1,00,000/- and below may be claimed through the concerned District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state the claims should be submitted in the Directorate. The prize-winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse of the tickets. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with the concerned counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time..

18. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prized tickets are collected, and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them while presenting the same for payment.

19. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only one prize ie, the highest prize offered. Income Tax and surcharge etc; if any, will be deducted from the prize amount at source as laid down in the Finance Act. (Central).

20. Legal jurisdiction of this lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
