ANNEXURE – III
THIRUVONAM BUMPER LOTTERY-2008(BR.3)
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.100/- only. One book of tickets will contain 10 tickets.
3. The first to third prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The Consolation prize of Rs.25,000/- each will be awarded to the tickets in other four series, having the same number of the Ist prize winning number.
5. The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The fifth to seventh prizes will be determined by drawing the last three digits once and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The eighth prize will be determined by drawing the last two digits ten times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. An amount equivalent to 10% of prize money will be deducted from Ist, IIIrd and consolation prizes and given as agents prize to the agents concerned. An amount of Rs.25,000/- each on 2nd prize ie., Maruti Alto (Standard) Car, an amount equivalent to 10% of the prize money on 4th and 5th, 20% on 6th, 25% on 7th and 50% on 8th prizes will be given as agents prize to the agents concerned from Government fund.
9. Admissible Income Tax as per Rule, Road Tax, Insurance for One Year and Registration Charge of Maruti Alto (Standard) Car will be met in full by the Government.
10. Registered agents will get the tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.
 - (a) Up to 1000 tickets - 80% of the maximum retail price
 - (b) Between 1,001 and 5000 tickets - 79.5% of the maximum retail price
 - (c) Between 5,001 and 10,000 tickets - 79% of the maximum retail price
 - (d) Between 10,001 and 1,00,000 tickets - 78.75% of the maximum retail price
 - (e) Between 1,00,001 and 3,00,000 tickets - 78.5% of the maximum retail price
 - (d) Between 3,00,001 and 5,00,000 tickets - 78.25% of the maximum retail price
 - (f) Between 5,00,001 and 7,50,000 tickets - 78% of the maximum retail price.
 - (g) Above 7,50,000 tickets - 77.5% of the maximum retail price

The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any, will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery, as the case may be, from the office of registration.

11. Thiruvonam incentive for agents based on the sale of Thiruvonam Bumper Lottery tickets will be given at the following rates after the draw.
 - a) Purchase upto 5000 tickets - Rs.100/- each for every 100 tickets.
 - b) For purchase upto 10,000 tickets - Rs.5000/- for the Ist 5000 tickets and Rs.250/- each for every 500 tickets thereafter.
 - c) For purchase above 10,000 tickets- Rs.7,500/- plus Rs.5,000/-each for every

10,000 tickets purchased over and above the first 10,000 tickets.

12. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows:-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of next lower purchaser.

13. Common incentive prize of Rs.2,000/- will be awarded to the agents registered in each district who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above 2,500 tickets. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets in a district, the amount will be divided among them equally. The agents who become eligible for special incentive vide clause 12 will not be eligible for common incentive.

14. The prize- winners shall prefer their claims within 30 days from the date of draw. The 1st and IInd prize winning tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by insured registered post or through Nationalised/ Scheduled Banks /State or District Co – operative Banks supported with necessary documents.

15. The prizes of Rs.1,00,000/- and below may be claimed from the District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state, the claims should be submitted in the Directorate. The prize-winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse side of the ticket. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time except in the case of 8th prizes.

16. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prize tickets are collected and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them, while presenting the same for payment.

17. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only the highest prize awarded on it. Income Tax and surcharge etc, if any, will be deducted at source from the prize money as laid down in the Finance Act. (Central).

18. Legal Jurisdiction of this Lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram.
